Artificial Intelligence at the Crossroads of Law, Ethics, Justice and Intelligence

What role does AI play in law? Does AI also possess a sense of justice, wisdom, maturity, and empathy?

Artificial intelligence (AI) offers many possibilities, but can it also judge what is fair and just? What is proportionate?

Will law and ethics restrict AI, or will AI begin to control the law and influence and change our ethical norms?

What AI lacks is a heart. Not a heart that merely pumps blood, but a heart that feels and, together with the other "elements," bestows humanity.

Therefore, artificial intelligence should, at least in some areas, complement natural intelligence and wisdom, not replace them.
