Letter of the President

Salzburg, 28 October 2024

Dear members of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts,

In my greetings from St. Peter in autumn 2024, I would first like to report on the upcoming election procedure in addition to the usual report on the activities of our Academy:

EASA election process

The elections for the new presidency 2026 are approaching. The schedule for the individual steps of the election process was explained and discussed at the last General Assembly in 2024. The schedule was once again communicated to all members in a round letter by the Vice-President for Internal Affairs. The chairman of the election committee is Prof. Zimmermann.

In recent weeks, some members have expressed the wish for an online election in which all members, including those from countries further away from Salzburg, could take part. For democratic reasons, it is certainly highly desirable that as many members as possible take part in the election. This topic was therefore discussed in detail at the last Presidium and Senate meeting on 18 October.

At these two meetings, it was made clear that an online election would require a change to the Academy's statutes, which are still based on a physical election at a General Assembly. An election by show of hands, which would be transmitted online, is conceivable. However, if a request is made for a secret ballot (which is to be assumed), this option is no longer available. An extraordinary general meeting in accordance with § 8(3) of the statutes would therefore have to be convened in any case for the possibility of an online election. This general meeting would have to take place in accordance with the conditions of the applicable articles of the current statutes, i.e. not online (as this is to be decided as an option at this general meeting). In doing so, it is important to take into account the time limit until the election date of 7 March 2025 decided at the last General Meeting.

It was pointed out that after Corona, the presidium and senate meetings have taken place in hybrid form (i.e. in person and online) in recent years. However, it should be borne in mind that the election of a new presidency is of extraordinary importance and must be unassailable from all points of view in order to ensure the legitimacy of the election and thus the future of the Academy under all circumstances. At the last presidium and senate meeting, after considering all aspects, the election procedure decided at the last General Assembly in accordance with the current statutes therefore appeared to be the safest way forward.

As President, I therefore ask all members of the Academy to participate in the election procedure in as large a number as possible in the spirit of democracy.

Danube Conference 8-10 October 2024

As important as such an election process is, an academy lives above all from its scientific activities. The last Danube Conference in Belgrade 8-10 October was a remarkable example, in which all national academies along the Danube participated. The theme this time was the Danube itself, which was analysed in an interdisciplinary manner in accordance with the profile of the European Academy from ecological, economic and historical-cultural points of view. In my opening statement, I reminded the audience that the Danube has been a European 'river of destiny' over the centuries and is closely linked to the history of this continent. I would like to thank all the speakers and participants for their commitment, and in particular the Serbian Academy of Sciences for its hospitality.

Meeting with the World Academy of Sciences and Arts 21-22 October 2024

Two important events took place in Maribor (Slovenia) on 21-22 October. On 21 October, there was a meeting between our European Academy of Sciences and Arts (EASA) and the President of the World Academy of Arts and Sciences (WAAS). Presidents, rectors and scientists from neighbouring academies and universities also took part in this meeting. The founding of the World Academy of Arts and Sciences goes back to an initiative by Albert Einstein and Bertrand Russell in the early 1950s. At that time, the Cold War was beginning in the wake of the atomic bomb. Albert Einstein, physicist and scientific icon of the 20th century, together with Bertrand Russell, the great mathematician and philosopher, wanted to call on the sciences and arts to join forces in a peace initiative across all political boundaries.

This concern is extremely topical today, as armed conflicts are once again threatening to become uncontrollable. For this reason, a 'Vision for a Global Peace Offensive' was adopted at this joint meeting, in which scientists and artists are called upon to take joint responsibility. In an opening statement, I recalled that, alongside the atomic bomb, artificial intelligence represents a global challenge today. Specifically, our commitments concern innovative educational and research activities for peace. In our further activities, we want to join forces to build a bright, secure and peaceful future for all.

The Alma Mater Europaea serves as the umbrella organisation for the joint initiative of the European Academy and the World Academy of Sciences and Arts. Garry Jacobs, President of the World Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the neurosurgeon Vinko Dolenc received honorary doctorates from the Alma Mater Europaea in Maribor at a ceremony on 22 October in the National Theater.

As usual, I would like to conclude my greetings by asking you to inform yourselves in the Salzburg office and our website to find out about the Academy's numerous events. My letter is followed by information on past and upcoming events organised by the Academy.



I wish you a pleasant autumn in the many countries that are connected with our Academy and hope that you will carry the message of our peace initiative to your countries.
