Letter of the President

Salzburg, 14 June 2024

Dear members of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts,

As president I warmly thank all members who took part on the academy's events at the occasion of the General Assemby and Festive Assembly 2024 in Salzburg. Presidium and Senate of the Academy hope that you enjoyed our events and had a save trip back home.

With respect to the elections 2025, there was a discussion at the general assembly about whether the members, although they have not paid, still have a right to vote. Presidium and Senate descided to handle this question in the future with the by-laws in Paragraph 4, Section 6:

"The membership expires

- On death, dissolution of the legal entity
- By means of a written declaration of resignation to the Presidium
- By removal by decision of the Presidium, if, despite repeated requests, no contribution to the activities of the Academy is to be expected and the member does not respond to notification of the impeding removal
- By exclusion by decision of the Senate for dishonourable behaviour against the Academy as well as for violation of the Statutes and membership obligations."

According to this paragraph, members who are not paying their dues and who will have been reminded multiple times may lose their membership, because they violate the membership obligations. Therefore, Presidium and Senate kindly remind the members of this rule. It will be used in order to decide on members, who in despite of repeated reminders, have not paid their dues, in future presidium meetings. Obviously, decisions about removal of membership need to be taken with utmost care. That will be considered case by case in the presidium, without changing the by-laws.

In order to support the visibility of the Academy, we used the announcements of EASA-projects in IAP (InterAcademy Partnership). In this report, EASA is said to aim at a transformation into an interdisciplinarily working academy. Therefore, beyond the significant achievements of its members, EASA initiated interdisciplinary expert groups to elaborate crucial topics for the future of Europe. There have been two expert groups on "Digitalization, Artificial Intelligence, and its Societal Impact" and "Energy, Environment, and Climate". The expert groups wrote already two White Papers which were certified by the Senate of the Academy, published in the EASA official journal, and led to discussions and invitations with national and international institutions.



Our Proceedings of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts (PEASA) were also highlighted in IAP together with our STEMAC-project (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, in Arts & Culture) and the different events and initiatives concerning the topic of tolerance.

I like to invite you to an upcoming conference on "Innovation and Integration: A symphony of history, technology and art" at 10-11 November 2024. ICIITSHA 2024 aims to deeply explore the intersection of technology and art, and explore the relationship, interaction, conflicts and challenges between the two, as well as the possibilities for future development, and to promote cross-border cooperation between science and technology and art, stimulate innovative thinking, explore the future development direction of science and technology and art, and contribute to building a future society where science and technology and culture are integrated.

Further on, the European Academy of Sciences and Arts together with the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts (SASA) cordially invite you to participate on the 13th Danube Academies Conference which will be held in Belgrade, Serbia on 9-10 October on the topic "*Green Blue Danube*". All topics should be related to the European Green Deal - preservation of Europe's natural capital, clean air and water, sustainable use of chemicals, food safety, transformation of agriculture and rural areas, clean and affordable energy, achieving climate neutrality, sustainable transport and the transition to a circular economy in the Danube region. The Danube Academies Conference is a forum for all national Academies of the Danube region and focuses on scientific developments in this area. With respect to the recent flood catastrophies of our big European rivers and their affluents, this conference will be highly topical.

The office will inform you about all these events in time. Please, consider also the online announcements of our events on the Academy's website carefully.
