Letter of the President

Salzburg, 11th July 2022

Dear members of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts,

Last week we had our festive plenary in Salzburg in physical presence for the first time after the pandemic. In addition to the General Assembly and the evening reception in the Salzburg Residence, this time there were workshops of the expert groups and current topics of the Academy such as the presentation of the new Academy Journal. I would like to thank all participating members of the Presidium, Senate and Academy for their outstanding commitment. Our thanks also go once again to our benefactor, who made the awarding of the Paul Crutzen Prize possible.

The Mozarteum had appropriately and beautifully arranged the musical framework programme of the festive plenary. I now ask for the committed cooperation of all Academy members with exciting contributions.
