Dazu unseren herzlichen Glückwunsch und Dank an alle Bewerber für ihr Engagement für die Akademie. Ab Dezember dieses Jahres werden das neue Präsidium und der neue Senat ihre Arbeit aufnehmen.

In den vergangenen Monaten fanden wieder eine Reihe bemerkenswerter Veranstaltungen mit und von der Europäischen Akademie statt. Die Themen reichen von Quantum Computing, Artificial Intelligence und Medizin zur Europäischen Politik und Religion und fanden in Brüssel, Bukarest, Cagliari, Florenz, Istanbul, Ljubljana, Kanton (Guangzhou), Madrid, Zagreb u.a. statt. Sie betrafen einzelne Klassen, aber auch fachübergreifend alle Klassen und sind im Anschluss an diese Greetings aufgelistet. Die Akademie ist also europäisch und international sichtbar.

Hervorheben möchte ich die gemeinsame Veranstaltung mit dem Think Tank STOA des Europäischen Parlaments in Brüssel und der World Academy of Arts and Sciences (WAAS), deren Gründung auf Albert Einstein zurückgeht. Im Rahmen der Veranstaltung von WAAS unter dem Titel „Global Turbulence: Sources and Solutions“ vom 21.-24. Juli, die weltweit ausgesendet wurde, war ein Tag unserer gemeinsamen „Peace Offensive“ der Wissenschaften und der Künste gewidmet, zu der WAAS und EASA im letzten Jahr eine gemeinsame Erklärung verfasst hatten.

Zum Abschluss möchte ich daran erinnern, dass seit Anfang dieser Woche der AI Act (»Verordnung über Künstliche Intelligenz«) der EU gilt. Er ist das erste transnationale Gesetz zur Regulierung Künstlicher Intelligenz (2. August 2025). Die Europäische Akademie hatte im Vorfeld verschiedene Initiativen dazu gestartet (z.B. gemeinsame Veranstaltung mit der EU-Universität EUI in Florenz 2023 mit dem Thema „KI in der Demokratie“, „Living Guidelines of Generative AI“ in der international führenden Wissenschaftszeitschrift NATURE 2023 mit Claudi Bockting und ihrer Arbeitsgruppe an der Universität Amsterdam). Ein Anliegen der Europäischen Union ist es, EU-Bürger*innen vor möglichen negativen Auswirkungen von KI-Anwendungen zu schützen und gleichzeitig die Innovation im Bereich vertrauenswürdiger Künstlicher Intelligenz zu fördern. Demgegenüber folgen die USA einer „Try-First Culture“ (J.D. Vance) ohne Regulierung. Im Wettbewerb mit den USA und China kommt es für Europa darauf an, die richtige Balance und das richtige Maß zwischen Risiko, Innovation und Regulierung zu finden.

Congratulations and thanks to all applicants for their commitment to the Academy. The new Presidium and the new Senate will take up their work in December of this year.



Over the past few months, a number of remarkable events have once again been organised with and by the European Academy. The topics ranged from quantum computing, artificial intelligence and medicine to European politics and religion and took place in Brussels, Bucharest, Cagliari, Canton (Guangzhou), Florence, Istanbul, Ljubjana, Madrid, Zagreb and others. They concerned individual classes, but also all classes across all subjects and are listed at the end of these greetings. The Academy therefore has a European and international profile.

I would like to emphasise the joint event with the European Parliament's STOA think tank and the World Academy of Arts and Sciences (WAAS), which was founded by Albert Einstein. As part of the WAAS event entitled 'Global Turbulence: Sources and Solutions' from 21-24 July, which was broadcast worldwide, one day was dedicated to our joint 'Peace Offensive' of the sciences and the arts, on which WAAS and EASA drew up a joint declaration last year.

Finally, I would like to remind you that the EU's AI Act ('Artificial Intelligence Regulation') has been in force since the beginning of this week. It is the first transnational law to regulate artificial intelligence (2 August 2025). The European Academy had launched various initiatives in advance (e.g. joint event with the EU University EUI in Florence 'AI in Democracy' 2023, 'Living Guidelines of Generative AI' in the leading international scientific journal NATURE 2023 with Claudi Bockting and her working group at the University of Amsterdam). One of the European Union's concerns is to protect EU citizens from possible negative effects of AI applications and at the same time to promote innovation in the field of trustworthy artificial intelligence. In contrast, the USA follows a 'try-first culture' (J.D. Vance) without regulation. In competition with the USA and China, it is important for Europe to find the right balance and the right measure between risk, innovation and regulation.

Food for thought for the holiday season. I wish all members a relaxing summer holiday, wherever you may be on this planet

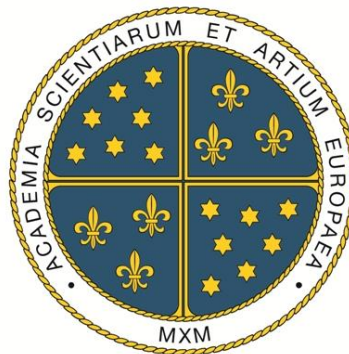


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
