Letter of the President

Salzburg, 8th April 2022

Dear members of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts,

Easter 2022 is not peaceful. We have war in Europe. Therefore, already in February, our Academy such as many other Academies in Europe strongly opposed the invasion and occupation of a sovereign European state like Ukraine by the armed forces of the Russian Federation, which is against international law. We declared our solidarity with the Ukrainian people and our Ukrainian colleagues, members of our European Academy of Sciences and Arts with a clear voting for democracy and academic freedom (compare website of the Academy).

After numerous public statements, it now comes down to our professional expertise as academics in the classes. We were of the opinion in the Senate that, for example, the theologians and religious scholars in Class VII could work on the religious background and traditions of this conflict, the economists and sociologists in Class V could work on the socio-economic background and consequences, environmental scientists on the environmental catastrophies of wars, lawyers and philosophers could work on the significance of international law, cultural scholars and historians could work on the historical and cultural background of this conflict, etc., etc. Corresponding working papers from the classes could be brought together at the end. However, this will certainly take time and require thorough discussion. Members who would like to get involved on these topics based on their subject expertise may please contact their deans.

As mentioned in previous Greetings, we have now also decided on an official journal of the Academy that will be launched on 2 July at the Annual Meeting/Fest Plenary. This new journal could later document the results of the processing of this conflict.

Separate invitations to the festive reception on the evening of Friday 1 July and to the Annual General Meeting/Festive Plenum on the afternoon of Saturday 2 July will be issued in due course. In addition, as already announced in the last Greetings, various workshops of our expert groups will take place in presence in Salzburg. All members of EASA will be cordially invited to these workshops with a programme in due course.

As a "save the date", I would ask you to make a note of a workshop on "Mental Health System" on Thursday, 30 June (coordinated by EASA members Günter Schiepek/Salzburg, Claudi Bockting / Amsterdam and others). The expert group "Digitalisation, AI, and Societal Impact" will meet on Friday morning (1 July), the expert group "Climate, Environment, and Energy" on Friday afternoon (1 July).

The presentation of the EASA journal and the workshop of the expert group "Innovation, Research, and Education" will take place on Saturday morning (2 July).

The topics of all our workshops concern a currently great challenge for Europe how to become more independent through innovation, research and science in order to secure future quality of life and



sustainability. We hope that many members from near and far will be motivated to visit summery Salzburg for these events. In addition, there will be enough time for travel planning.

For current events, I would like to ask all members to check the Academy's website. Attention should be drawn to the lecture series which started in March entitled "Health. Society in Crisis?", which is organised by the Medical University of Vienna and the University of Vienna together with the European Academy of Sciences and Arts.

On 20 April 2022, the presentation of the commemorative publication "30 Years of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts" by the Honorary President of EASA Felix Unger will take place in the EASA meeting room.
